Friday 29 commences with variable winds from
north to N.W. sharing S. by W. at sunset took
in the light sails middle & last calms with
light airs from Westward heading South &
ends lat 2.50 S long 59.25 E

Saturday 30 commences with cloudy squally
weather & light breezes from W. steering to South
at 4 PM stood down to sails hauled up the
booms middle & last cabin at daylight hoisted
up the topsails & set all sail so ends lat 3.00 S
long 59.35 E

Sunday December the 1. 1850
commences fine with light airs from Eastward
heading S. & W. under all sail sent the foretop
sail down & repaired it middle and fore
heading to S. & W. so ends lat 3.12 S long 59.41 E

Monday 2 commences with fine breezes from
S. & E. steering to S. & W. at 8 PM took in the
light sails for the night with squally rainy
weather with the wind from W. & S. at 9 PM
wore ship to W. by N. at 12 AM wore to
the S. & at 4 the wind hauled to S. & W.
wore ship to the W. the topsails down on
the cap last fine made all sail heading
to the N. & W. so ends lat 3.07 S long 60.00 E

Tuesday 3 commences fine with moderate
breezes from the Westward heading to the
N. & W. at sunset took in the light sails &

duble reefed the topsails took in the fore & spanker
at daylight made all sail and tacked to S. & W.
so ends lat 2.22 S long 60.11 E

Wednesday 4 commences cloudy with fresh
breezes from W. & S. heading to the S. & W.
middle & last the same at daylight tacked
to the S. & W. the wind hauled from W. & S.
to W. & W. at 11 AM tacked to the S. & W.
so ends lat 2.45 S long 60.11 E

Thursday 5 commences with brisk breezes from
W. & W. heading to the S. & W. under all sails
middle & last fine under all sail so ends
lat 3 long 60.45 E

Friday 6 commences squally with rain under
all sail the wind from W. & W. heading S. & W.
at 4 PM took a squall took in the light sails
duble reefed the topsails took in the fore and
spanker middle & last the same from W.
N. & W. to N. & W. at 8 PM wore ship to N.
at 9 PM wore to W. last fine made
all sail at daylight tacked to N. so ends

Saturday 7 commences fine with moderate breezes
from S. & W. heading to N. under all sail middle
and last the wind from S. & W. to N. & W.
working to the Windward first on tack & then
the other so ends lat 2.22 S long 61.45 E

Sunday 8 commences fine with moderate
breezes from N. & W. heading N. by E under all
sail middle fine heading N. & W. so fine backs
so ends
