last squally at daylight dable reached the topsails
at 12 P.M. the wind from the N. N. W. heading
to S. E. & so ends

Thursday 9 commences rainy & squally with
strong breezes from N. W. heading S. E. &
middle cloudy at whole topsail heading N. at
daylight made all sail so ends lat 03.10 S
long 56 11 E

Friday 10 commences fine with light winds
from N. N. W. heading W. under all sail middle
squally rainy weather wind variable heading to the
N. E. W. at daylight set the light sails the wind
from N. W. W. heading W. so ends

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Saturday 11 commences with cloudy weather
the wind from N. N. W. heading to Westward
under all sail middle & last rainy weather the
from N. W. heading to the windward so ends

middle and last squally the wind from N. W.
at 12 A.M. tacked to West so ends lat 03.16 S
long 58 37 E

Monday 13 commences squally with strong
breezes from S. S. W. heading to West under all sail
middle & last fine with strong breezes heading
W. so ends lat 03 35 S long 57 12 E

Tuesday 14 commences fine with strong breezes
from S. S. W. heading W. under all sail so breezes
middle and last the same at daylight so
Proton being S. W. so ends lat 03.50 S 56.00 E

Wednesday 15 commences cloudy with strong breezes
from S. heading W. P. M. Dennis Harb and
Proton & North Island in sight North Island
bearing S. W. by S distance about 25 miles middle
& last the same heading W. so two sails so ends
lat 04.00 S long 54 09 E

Thursday 16 commences fine with strong breezes
from N. N. W. heading W. three sails in sight to work
making reggin middle & last the same heading to
the Westward to work fitting reggin so ends
lat 4.33 S long 52 45 E
