

Barque Brunett Towards the Western Ground
 Tuesday June 13th 1843 these 24 hours commenced with moderate breezes from the N^W the Barque heading N^W by middle & latter part wind N^E heading N^W the watch variously employed in ships duty.

Lat by obs 9° 32' N
 Long 26° 51' W

Wednesday June 14th 1843 these 24 hours strong N^E trade winds lashed and relashed several times in the course of the night to avoid Stannack's corral. Sheal latter part Barque heading N^W bent and set the fore topmast stay sail and ran new main topgallant sheet saw one Sheal of porpoises going up and out to the windward thus ends

Thursday June 15th 1843 these 24 hours strong N^E trade Barque heading N^W middle part much the same latter part strong winds and rugged handed fly jib and fore topgallant sail the watch employed in making scrub teeth. Levi complains of being quite unwell Ch^d Abase and the Cooper about half sick

Friday June 16th 1843 strong trades and some squally Barque heading N^W put the waste Boat on the upper cranes the watch employed as yesterday nothing in sight from the mast head worth nothing

Lat in 13° 13' N
 Long in 30° 31' W

Saturday June 17th 1843 these 24 hours strong trades and rugged steering N^W by Levi knee down sick his face broke out with red blotches and strong symptoms of the small pox Capt Luce bled him he seemed much better after words.

Lat by obs 15° 35' N
 Long by Chro 32° 02' W

Sunday June 18th 1843 commenced with squally weather handed on sat the light sails several times at 6 P.M. the Capt was taken severely ill vomiting and cramp in the stomach and very much deranged by spells continued in this way till in the evening when he seemed some better; at 11 A.M. he bled himself and felt much relieved by it.

Monday June 19th 1843 all these 24 hours strong N^E steering N^W Capt in the evening had some most down sick myself Levi and the rest of the sick folks some better but after all we are poor prepared for what is coming
