

George Bennett towards Falmouth  
 Friday these 24 hours commenced with fresh breezes from the  
 July 28 Northward steering West as a course after 4 PM filled 12  
 1843 barrels with salt water stowed them in the fore peak  
 to trim Ship with middle part moderate latter part  
 light air & calm at daylight commenced working the  
 mast off and backing the chain plates at 10 finished  
 them and commenced painting the Starboard side;  
 I am quite unwell to day wish I could procure some  
 medical aid

Saturday  
 July 29 first part light breezes from the Westward Barque  
 1843 heading Sth. middle part light breezes from N by E  
 Barque heading N by E latter part light air and  
 calm Boarded Brig Granite Npton 6 days from  
 Salem bound to Cian; Capt Npton kindly supplied  
 us with some medicine sugar & new papers and potatoes  
 wished me to remember him to Mrs Dexter;

Sunday  
 July 30 these 24 hours light air from the Westward  
 1843 Barque heading N by E at 8 raised a sail steering  
 to the Eastward; every body seems to have a fair  
 wind but us; however kind Providence knows  
 what is best for our good

Eddy Mo Luce Master  
 Monday these 24 hours light air from the Sth steering  
 July 31 to N by E as a course at 2 PM raised Black fish  
 1843 lowered two boats got two to the waste Boat and  
 struck the third one the view drawn missed two  
 to my Boat as usual middle & latter part fine  
 beautiful weather all hands employed in boiling  
 and painting Ship; course West; another year had  
 rolled over my head which makes me 24 if my  
 memory serves me right

Tuesday  
 August 1 light air from the Southward steering N by E  
 1843 as a course sailed out the Black Fish Clubb  
 in the after noon at 4 PM saw three sails

 Barque and commenced on the Starboard Boat  
 picked up 2 vessels deck beam and fly jib  
 board saw Grampuses & Cowfish

Wednesday  
 Aug 2 these 24 hours light breezes throughout from  
 S to Sth course N by E finished the Starboard  
 Boat and commenced on the Starboard latter
