and fine weather steered E. by E
at sunset close reefed the top
sails for night course E. by E
Middle part strong gales
Latter much the same steered East

begins with

saw fin
Middle part squally
Latter the same with a breeze
saw fin Backs no ends

For Whales at Tristan Da Cunha
Wednesday Septm 10th
begins with fresh gales at N by E
and rough sea steered E by E
saw fin Backs and Birds plenty
Middle part strong breezes and
squally steered E by E
Latter the same saw a Dark Ship
steering SE saw nothing of the whale kind

Lat by Obs 34° 12' S
Long by Chron 3° 19' 30' W
Thursday Septm 11th Long by Obs Dist 3° 33' W
begins with fresh gales at West and
squally steered E. by E saw fin Backs
at sunset double reefed the top sails
for the night nothing in sight
Middle part fine
Latter strong breezes and rough
sea steered E by E saw a sail ahead
steering E. by E No Obs

Friday Septm 12th
begins with fresh gales and cloudy
weather steered E. at 2 PM the
wind veered to N by E
the yards
Middle part
rainy Latter
with squalls saw nothing
Lat by Obs 34° 22'
Long 2° 19' E

Saturday Septm 13th
begins with fresh breezes at N by E
steering E. by E saw fin Backs one
strange sail in sight
Middle part fresh gales
Latter the same saw nothing
Lat 34° 19' Long 4° 45' East
