

Ship Brunswick Pursing
Sunday Septm 14th
Begin with fresh gales at 12th
and rough sea steered E S E
at sunset shortened sail for night
Middle part fresh gales
Latter heavy gales at 12th steered
E S E saw nothing Lat 48° 34' 08" S
Long 7° 29' 30" East

Monday Septm 15th
Begin with heavy gales at 12th
and rough sea steered E S E at
5 PM took in sail bore to head S W
Middle part a gale
Latter fine weather made all sail
stood to the S E saw fin Backs
Lat 48° 34' 19" S
Long 9° 08' East

Tuesday Septm 16th
Begin with fine weather brisk
breezes at 12th stood to the S E
saw fin Backs saw 1st hump
Middle part a gale
Latter fine weather steered to S E
saw fin

Lat 34° 38' S
Long 10° 58' East
17th

Wednesday
Begin with strong gales and rain
at 12 PM bore to head to S W
Middle part the same
Latter a heavy gale and
very heavy rain still lay too
head to the S W
saw nothing of the whale kind
Lat 35° 21' S
Long 11° 23' E

For 12 miles
Thursday Septm 18th
Begin with a heavy gale at 12th
Laying to head to S W with
a tremendous sea running
Middle part a heavy gale
Latter more moderate headed to the
N W at 10 AM putted one of the
Cock Stays, replaced it with a piece
of the ship's small chain
Lat 48° 35' 22" S
Long 11° 53' East

Friday Septm 19th
Begin with fresh gales at 12th headed
to the S W under short sail
at sunset took in sail headed
to the S W nothing of the whale
kind seen this day
Middle part moderate
Latter fine weather saw plenty
of fin Backs Lat 48° 34' 00" S
Long 10° 53' East

Saturday Septm 20th
Begin with fine weather light
westerly winds to the North
saw great 2nd of fin Backs
at sunset in headed North
Middle part
Latter the same saw plenty fin Backs

Lat 48° 35' S
Long 11° 32' E

Sunday Septm 21st
Begin fine weather E S E saw
fin Backs at 5 PM spoke the
Ship Grandt New Bedford
Middle part fine headed to the East
Latter the same saw fin Backs
Lat 32° 48' S Long 13° 48' East
