Middle part fine

Later the same saw fin Backs
Lat 30° 00'

Ship Brunswick

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Saturday Oct 11th
Begins with brisk breeze fine weather
stood to the S.W. saw fin Backs
spoke ship John Adams. hantucket
1300 lbs. 14 months out saw ship
Thomas Miller & Brunswick no oil
Middle part fine weather steered to
the S.W. by the wind

Later incline to calm saw fin Backs
two ships in sight Lat 30° 36'

Sunday Oct 12th

Begins with light air fine weather
at 2 P.M. calm no whales in sight

Middle part fine weather stood
to the S.W. saw one whale chased
could not strike Later the
same spoke ship Election of
New London no oil Lat 30° 52'

Long 10° 27' E

Monday Oct 13th

Begins with fine weather stood
to the S.W. saw one whale
chased could not strike

Middle part
Later the same no whale
Lat 31° 11' S

Long 10° 41' E

Tuesday Oct 14th

Begins with calm and pleasant
weather no whales yet almost
6 months out heard huck

Middle part calm
Later the same with fog
saw one fin Back

Lat 31° 16' S

Long 11° 00' E
