Monday Decm 15th

Begins with fresh breezes and fine weather steered E S E saw fin backs or a podpoises at 10 AM shortned gale for night steering E S E no whales Middle part light breezes with fog Latter the same saw nothing steered E S E No Ho

Tuesday Decm 16th

Begins with light breezes and thick fog steered E S E at 6 PM saw whales chased could not strike the one Bark in night Middle part moderate Latter strong gales and rough saw no whales five ships in night one Boiling Lat 36° 24 Long 7° 32

Wednesday Decm 17th

Begins with strong gales and rough sea saw whales chased could not strike took in sail at 3 PM saw more lowered one Boat could not fetch Middle part more moderate Latter fine weather Lat 36° 20 Long 7° 26

Thursday Decm 18th

Begins with fine weather stood to the N W saw fin backs saw a ship take a whale saw another Boiling four others in night Middle and Latter part fine Caught two whales No Ho

Ship Brunswick 1834 ³³

Friday Decm 19th

Begins with light airs and fine weather at 12 noon took the whales along side at 1 PM commenced cutting at 8 PM finished began to boil fire Ships in sight two of them Boiling Middle part fine weather Latter the same saw no whales five ships in sight none Boiling Lat 36° 16 Long 7° 28

Saturday Decm 20th

Begins with fine weather stood to the S W saw no whales at sunset took in sail for night Middle part fine weather Latter fresh gales all hands employd in Boiling saw no whales Lat 36° 58 Long 7° 39

Sunday Decm 21st

Begins with fresh gales at 10 AM and cloudy all hands employd in Boiling Middle part the same Latter fine weather all hands employd in Boiling and stowing down saw no whales Lat 36° 38

Monday Decm 22d

Begins with fine weather all hands employd in Boiling and stowing down at 8 PM finished Boiling saw whales did not lower Middle and Latter part light winds saw no whales finished stowing down Lat 36° 15 Long 6° 46
