Tuesday Decm 23<sup>d</sup>  
Begins with fine weather light  
winds spoke ship South Carolina  
of Portsmouth with 1400 barrels  
Middle part calm  
Latter the same got two barks  
of Bread out of South Carolina  
saw no whales

Long by Obs 6° 19'  
Long by Chron 6° 29'

Wednesday Decm 24<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fine weather light  
winds stood to the S<sup>W</sup> saw no whales  
Middle part fresh breezes stood to  
Latter strong gales and rough  
saw no whales spoke ship  
Portion of New Bedford wood bbls

Lat 36° 55'  
Long by Obs 7° 11'  
Long by Chron 7° 12'

Thursday Decm 25<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with strong gales and rough  
sea stood to the N<sup>W</sup> at 4 P<sup>M</sup>  
fresh gales and rain took in fore tops  
Middle part thick fog  
Latter part thick cloudy weather  
saw plenty of whales lowered  
struck and drew out the whale

Lat 37° 45'  
Long 7° 37'

Friday Decm 26<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with thick cloudy weather at  
1 P<sup>M</sup> saw whales chased could not fasten  
Middle part moderate with fog  
Latter fine weather stood to  
the S<sup>W</sup> saw no whales

Lat 38° 26' Long 7° 35' by Obs  
Long by Chron 7° 35'

Ship Brunswick 1834 <sup>35</sup>  
Saturday Decm 27<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with fresh breezes and fine  
weather stood to the S<sup>W</sup> saw  
Humpbacks at sunset took in sail  
Middle part moderate  
Latter brisk breezes and fine weather  
stood to the West saw no whales  
saw a ship steering S<sup>W</sup>

Lat 37° 53'  
Long 7° 11'

Sunday Decm 28<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with brisk breezes and cloudy  
weather stood to the West saw  
nothing at sunset shortened sail  
set whole watches for night  
Middle part moderate winds S<sup>W</sup>  
Latter light airs at S<sup>W</sup> saw fin  
backs no ends

Lat 38° 22'  
Long 7° 21'

Monday Decm 29<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with calm and pleasant  
weather four ships in sight  
saw Grampuses and fin backs  
Middle part calm  
Latter light breezes and fine weather  
saw no whales two ships in sight

Lat 38° 29' S  
Long 6° 39' S

Tuesday Decm 30<sup>th</sup>  
Begins with brisk breezes at S<sup>W</sup>  
and fine weather steered N<sup>W</sup> at  
1 P<sup>M</sup> saw a whale going fast to S<sup>W</sup>  
chased could not strike

Middle part strong breezes and  
fog stood to the S<sup>W</sup> at 12 noon  
clear saw whales did not fasten
