Sunday March 15th
Begins with fresh breezes at S.E.
and squalls of wind and rain
steered East

Middle part strong breezes and
squally
Latter light breezes and
cloudy with a heavy mist

Lat 28° 29'
Long 36° 45'

Monday March 16th
Begins with ~~fresh~~ squally
weather wind East and
very light at sunset Calm

Middle part calm
Latter strong North winds
steered East saw nothing

Lat 27° 54' 35"
Long 37° 48'

Tuesday March 17th
Begins with strong North
winds and cloudy steered East
at sunset I reefed the top sail
steered E.S.E.

Middle part strong breezes and
squally with rain
Latter the same saw a sail
steering East saw no whales

Lat 27° 07'

Wednesday March 18th
Begins with strong breezes at North
steered E.S.E. with 2 reefed top sail
Middle part fine

Latter the same saw nothing
of the whale kind

Lat 25° 38'
Long 41° 31'

In Mozambique Channel 1835

Thursday March 19th
Begins with brisk N.W. winds attended
with light squalls of rain steered
E.S.E. saw no whales at sunset
I reefed the top sails for night
Middle part calm

Latter brisk breezes and fine
weather steered to the Eastward
saw no whales

Lat 25° 07'
Long 42° 45'
Long by Lunar 42° 33'

Friday March 20th
Begins with fine weather
light winds

Middle part calm
Latter light breezes saw
nothing

Lat 25° 08'
Long 43° 19'

Saturday March 21st
Begins with fine weather brisk
breezes steered to the East
saw two whale ships

Middle part light air steered
to the North saw two ships
standing to the North

Latter fine weather steered
E.S.E. at 4 P.M. saw the
Island of Madagascar
bearing E.S.E. distant 48 miles
steered in for the ... ends

Lat 24° 15'
Long 43° 12'
