Saturday April 11th

Begins with fine weather light winds at 1 PM started at 5 PM saw Europa Island bearing north 12 miles took in sail sheaved to N. the ship George and Martha in company

Middle part calm
Latter light breezes sent a boat on shore for turtle

Sunday April 12th

Begins with fine weather laying off Europa for turtle
Middle part fine

Latter the same got two turtle stood off shore spoke ship Grand Turk killed four birds

Monday April 13th

All there 24 hours fine weather light winds saw no whales
This day John Graham denied his duty

Lat 21° 55'
Long 39° 57'

Tuesday April 14th

Begins fine weather light air and variable

John Graham returned to his duty

Middle part calm

Latter light air stood to the SE saw Ganspures

Lat 21° 50'
Long 39° 50'

in Mozambique Passage

Wednesday April 15th

Begins with fine weather light winds stood to the SE saw no whales at sunset double reefed the top sails Middle part light air stood to the SE

Latter much the same stood to the SE saw no whales Lat 21° 34'
Long 40° 43'

Thursday April 16th

Begins with brisk 1 PM winds and fine weather stood to the SE spoke ship George & Martha Middle part fine weather

Latter the same stood to the SE saw nothing Lat 21° 45' S
Long 40° 49' East

Friday April 17th

Begins with fine weather brisk 1 PM winds stood to the N. Middle part fine stood to the SE

Latter brisk breezes stood to N. saw no whales Lat 21° 54'
Long 40° 14'

Saturday April 18th

Begins with fine weather brisk 1 PM winds stood to N. saw no whales

Middle part fine weather stood to the N.

Latter the same saw nothing of the whale kind

Lat 21° 21'
Long 39° 04' E.
