 Begins with fresh gales at
 1st stood in for the
 Land
 Middle part a gale

 Lat 23° 42'
 Long 85° 52'

Sunday April 26th
 Begins with strong gales
 stood in for the Land
 at 2 PM saw the Land
 Middle and Latter part the
 same headed to the E
 Lat 21° 30'
