Thursday April 30th
 Begins and ends with fine
 weather and no fish
 Lat 28° 33'
 Long 36° 32'

 Begins with fine
 and calm weather
 Middle part calm
 Latter fresh breezes and fine
 weather saw Black fish
 stood to the SSW
 Lat 24° 11'
 Long 36° 04'

Saturday May 2d
 Begins with fine weather
 steered Sth saw two ships
 Middle part brisk breezes and
 fine weather headed East
 Latter strong gales and squally
 stood to the Nth saw no fish
 Lat 24° 14'
 Long 35° 48'

Sunday May 3d
 Begins with strong gales
 and rough sea stood to the
 Sth at sunset headed ship
 head to S & E one ship in sight
 Middle part more moderate
 Latter fine caught a Black fish
 Lat 24° 46'
 Long 35° 34'
 Long 35° 56'

Monday May 4th
 Begins with fine weather stood
 to Nth saw the Land at
 sunset headed ship head to East
 Middle and Latter part calm
 Lat 25° 10'
 Long 35° 39'
 Long 35° 16'
