

Remarks On Board Ship
Friday June 19th
Begins with fresh SE
winds and heavy mist stood in
for the land at 5 PM tacked
ship head of shore the land
10 miles distant
Middle part fine weather
stood to the ESE
Latter fine weather stood to
the SW Lat 13.30
Long 50.25

Saturday June 20th
Begins with fine weather
with SE trades stood to the
SW at sunset tacked ship
head to ESE the land 8 miles
distant this is hard getting
to windward
Middle part fine weather
Latter the same lost six
miles this 24 hours with all sail
set tacking ship whenever
the wind veered Lat 13.24
Long 51.84

Sunday June 21st
Begins with fine trades
and fine weather stood
off shore
Middle part fine weather
stood to the East
Latter the same headed E by S
by the wind with all sail set
lowered a boat found the current
setting N. N. W. 2 knots so ends
Lat 14.53
Long 51.56
Long Chron 51.4

Brunswick 1835 N.H.S. Mass ⁸¹
Monday June 22d
Begins with fresh SE by S winds
and fine weather stood to the
E by S by the wind with all sail set
Saw nothing
Middle part fresh breezes and
squalls of rain
Latter light breezes from ESE
and fine weather stood to the
south by the wind saw one
Hump Back whale Lat 12.35
Long 52.26

Tuesday June 23d
Begins with light breezes at ESE
and fine weather stood to the
south by the wind saw no fish
Middle part fine weather
steered S by N by the wind
Latter the same saw nothing
Lat 13.56
Long Chron 51.59

Wednesday June 24th
Begins with brisk ESE winds
and fine weather stood to the
S by N with all sail set saw
one Hump Back whale
Middle part fine weather
brisk breezes
Latter the same Lat 15.10
Long 51.21

Thursday June 25th
Begins with fine weather brisk
SSE winds stood to the S by N at
1 PM saw the Land Cape East
Middle part fine stood to the SE
Latter fine stood to the SW
Lat 15.27 Long 51.32
