

Remarks On Board

Friday June 26
Begins with fine weather
fresh breezes stood to the SW
at sunset no land in sight
Middle part fine
Latter the same stood to the
SW saw the Land Land
Lat 15.42
Long 51.18

Saturday June 27th
Begins with fine S. E. trades
and pleasant weather stood
to the SW at sunset the North
head of the Bay bore west
distant 25 miles

Middle part fine weather
stood to the S. W.
Latter fine steered in for the
Land at 12 noon found the
Point Dumfries as shown on charts
Lat 16.05
Long 50.00

Sunday June the 28
Begins with fine weather
with S. E. winds steered S. W.
up the Bay at 8 1/2 P. M. came
to anchor in 23 fathoms
water with the small anchor
veered to a wide chain set
the watch

at 8 AM took our anchor and
proceeded up the Bay at 12 noon
came to anchor in Morove
harbor in 10 fathoms water
with the small anchor all hands
employed in unberthing sails and
getting ready for whaling

Monday June 29th
All these 24 hours fine weather
employed in various jobs one watch
on shore on liberty one cutting wood

Tuesday June 30th
Begins with variable winds and
rains one watch on liberty
the rest cutting wood

Wednesday July 1st
Begins with fresh south winds
and heavy rain employed in
wooding Paul & other jobs

Thursday July 2d
All these 24 hours
fresh gales with rains employed
in wooding one watch on liberty

Friday July 3d
Begins with moderate
gales and fine weather employed
in wooding and getting ready for
whaling

Saturday July 4th
Begins with strong breezes
and rain at daylight fire
a gun at 12 noon four
kept the day as well as our
situation would allow half
the crew on shore on liberty

Sunday July 5th
All these 24 hours
thick rainy weather
employed in various jobs
