Saturday July 11th
Begins with fine weather the Boats of whaling saw plenty could not fasten

Sunday July 12th
All these 24 hours fresh gales at 10 one walrus on shore on liberty

Monday July 13th
All these 24 hours fresh gales and rainy we have quit whaling till the whales shall have calf when we hope to get them one walrus cutting wood had a man hurt by the fall of a tree L. P. B. Cook

Tuesday July 14th
All this day fresh gales and rain

Wednesday July 15th
All this day fresh gales with rain

Thursday July 16th
Begins with light winds and constant rain the Boats of whaling got none

Friday July 17th
Begins with fine weather struck one whale took him to the ship cut him in

Saturday the 18th
All this day employed in whaling and boiling

Sunday July 19th
Begins with fresh breezes and rain the Boats off whaling employed in boiling
