Thursday August 20th

very fine killed two whales took them to the Packet

Friday August 21st

All this day very fine employd in whaling

Saturday August 22^d

All this day fresh gales and rain

Sunday August 23^d

All these 24 hours fine killed one whale struck another and cut the line lost two Harpoons

Monday August 24th

very fine the Boats off whaling

Tuesday August 25th

All this fine all hands employd in wooding and watering

M. Antigua Bay 1835

Wednesday August 26th

all these 24 hours calm and pleasant weather employd in stowing down oil

Thursday August 27th

Begins with light southerly winds and fine weather all hands employd in heaving sails for sea

Friday August 28th

Begins fine at 12 noon took our anchor and run up to the town to take in some Beef

Saturday August 29th

All these 24 hours fine getting ready for sea

Sunday August 30th

All these 24 hours fine weather one watch on liberty

Monday August 31st

Begins with fine weather one watch on liberty took on board ten Barrells of Beef sent on shore 2 barrells of oil
