Tuesday Septm 1st
All this day fine weather all ready for sea the first opportunity one watch on liberty on shore roads

Wednesday Septm 2d
Commences with light N.E. winds and fine weather Took our anchor and proceeded down the Bay at 3 PM came too at the Island of Morore with the small anchor fresh gales at 10 PM

Thursday Septm 3d
Begins with light airs and thick rainy weather at 3 PM took our anchor and stood down the Bay roads

Friday Septm 4th
Begins with fine weather and light N.E. winds three ships in company working out of the Bay

Saturday Septm 5th
All this day fine weather at 12 noon Sunifords stood bore North miles from which I take my departure for whale ground so end civil account and thus ends Antongil

Ship Brunswick for Whaling
Sunday Septm 6th
Commences with light winds and variable unless the chains and stowed the anchors

Lat 16. 08. S
Long 49. 50 E

Monday Septm 7th
Begins with fresh E.S.E. winds and fine weather at 3 PM tacked head to E.S.E. at 6 PM spoke ship Washington
Middle part fine
Latter the same the watch employed in ships duty

Lat 16. 15
Long 50. 10 E

Tuesday Septm 8th
Begins with fresh breezes at 1 PM headed to the East at 4 PM tacked ship read to the S.W.

Middle part fine
Latter the same employed in mending sails
Lat 17. 30 S
Long 49. 50 E

Wednesday Septm 9th
Begins with fresh S.E. winds and flying clouds headed to the S.W. two ships in sight
Middle part fine
Latter the same headed S.W. saw the Land roads

Lat 17. 45
Long 50. 10
