Monday Septm 28th
Begins with light S winds
and cloudy stood to the N with
all sail set saw fin backs and
plenty of birds no whales yet
middle part strong SE
winds and cloudy

Latter part fresh ESE winds
and squally saw fin backs

Long 0ls 45.15

The Long by 0ls is 2.44 miles east of Chron

Tuesday Septm 29th
Begins with fresh north
winds and squalls of rain stood
to the N with all sail set saw
fin backs saw a dark ship steering
to the eastward did not speak
middle part fine weather
Latter the same saw plenty
of fin backs
