 from SSW
 Latter light East winds
 and fine weather steered
 NW. saw fin backs
 the watch employed in repairing
 fore top sail Lat 35.19 S
 Long 30.16 E

Wednesday Oct. 7th
 All of the 24 hours fine
 weather. light Easterly winds
 steered NW. saw
 nothing the watch mending
 fore top sail Lat 35.31 S
 Long 28.24 E

Thursday Oct 8th
 Begins with fresh E. S. E winds and
 fine weather steered West saw
 fin backs finished the fore top
 sail and stowed it away
 Middle part strong breezes
 single reefed the top sails

Latter part moderate gales at
 NE and heavy sea saw fin backs
 Lat 36.27 S
 Long 26.15 E

Friday Oct 9th
 Begins with light breezes at NE
 steered West at 4 PM wind
 with fresh gales stood to SSW
 saw fin backs
 Middle part light breezes made
 all sail
 Latter brisk breezes and
 fine weather stood to the SSW
 by the wind saw nothing
 Lat 37.57 S
 Long 26.37 E

Saturday Oct 10th
 Begins with fresh breezes at
 West and fine weather stood to
 SSW at 4 PM single reefed the
 top sails took in main top gallant sail
 Middle part fine
 Latter the same saw one whale
 Lower a did not fasten
 Lat 39.38 S
 Long 26.48 E
