Springer departed the ship

Monday Feb 8th
All this day fine all hands
employed in getting ready for
sea. Springer not yet
heard of

Tuesday Feb 9th
All this fine weather all
ready for sea took on board
12 casks of potatoes and
800 pounds bread 40 gallons
molasses are now detained
on the account of Isaac Springer

Wednesday Feb 10th
Begins with fine weather at
6 A M took our anchor and
proceeded to sea to end

Thursday Feb 11th
Begins with fine weather light
SE trades. Course N by E
with all sail set
Middle and latter part
fine weather all hands employed
in setting up rigging one sail
in night

Lat 14. 51
Long 7. 31 W

Friday Feb 12th
Begins with fine weather and
fine trades all sail set
Course N by E
Middle part light air
Latter very light saw nothing
this day at noon the sun was
vertical all hands employed in
ships duty

Lat 13. 54 S
Long 8. 47 W

Saturday Feb 13th
Begins with light SE trades
and fine weather. Course N by E
with all drawing sail set
Middle part light breeze
Latter the same all hands
employed in ships duty

Lat 13. 03 S
Long 9. 57 W
