Begins with light airs at ESE stood
to the South at 3 PM light airs
at West steered ESE three sail
in sight saw grasshoppers

and rough sea steered E by S under
short sail
Middle part strong gales
Latter the same saw nothing
Lat 37.231
Long by Chron 56.10
Long by Obs 55.27

Wednesday July 20th
Begins with strong breezes at
West and rough sea steered E by S
with all necessary sail set

Middle part strong squalls
Latter fine weather
saw nothing
Lat 37.21
Long Obs 56
Long Chron 52.54
58 miles to fur
ther
