Wednesday August 17th
Begins with light SE winds
and fine weather at 12 noon
saw the Ship Canton Packet ret-
her colors half topmast hauled
up the mainsail and hove aback
for him the Capt. of which
informed me that he lost a man
Thomas Farman a seaman from
of the Jibboom whilst engaged
in getting up the rigging
the boat was immediately
lowered to save the man but
to no purpose before the boat
got to him he was to rise
no more

Latter part strong breezes and
squally stood to South

Thursday August 18th
Begins with fresh SE and squally
stood SSE two sail in sight
Middle part strong breezes
and squally
Latter the same saw
one sail ahead
