Begins with strong W. N. winds
attended with squalls steered
to the S.E. by the wind saw fin. seals
Middle part squally
Latter part calm saw no whales

Saturday Septm 24th
Begins with calm and pleasant
weather at 3 PM light airs at S.E.
Steered S.W. with all drawing sail set
Middle part strong breezes at
S.E. and squally with rain
Latter strong gales at S.E. with heavy
rain Lay too close to the

Sunday Septm 25th
Begins with hard gales at S.E. and
hard squalls took in main top sail
Middle part strong gales from S.W.
Steered ship to S.E.
Latter fine weather light West
winds and smooth sea headed
to the South saw two bright
whales going quick to the West
Lat 34.41.5
Long 24.39.0

Monday Septm 26th
Begins with light West winds and
fine weather steered to the South
Middle part fine steered South
Latter fine saw a few whales
took one and parted the line
lowered for another did not fasten
