All of these 24 hours variable winds and squalls saw two ships saw fin backs Lat 37.10

Begins with strong S.W. winds and squally steered E.N.E. at dark took in sail

Thursday Oct 20th

Begins with a gale at N.W. and heavy squalls steered N.E. at sunset took in the fore sail Lay too head to the North saw fin backs

Middle part a gale

Latter much the same saw whales chased could not fasten saw three ships Lat 35.34

Long 23.25 W

Friday Oct 21st

Begins with fresh breezes at west and cloudy stood to the North saw one fin back

Middle part more moderate

Latter the same saw nothing

Lat 33.34

Saturday Oct 22nd

Begins with light breezes at N.W. at 2 PM saw whales several chased and galled saw others struck and killed one at 9 PM took him along side

Middle and latter part fine cut in the whale Lat 35.35 S
