Tuesday Oct 25th

Begins with fresh gales at N.W.
and rough sea stood to the S.W.

Middle part strong gales

Latter the same stowed down
70 barrels of oil

Wednesday Oct 26th

Begins with strong gales at N.W.
and rough sea headed to the S.E.

Middle part heavy gales

Latter more moderate stood to S.E.

Lat 34.50

Long 21.50

Thursday Oct 27th

Begins with fresh breezes at S.W. and
rough sea headed to the S.E.

Middle part calm

Latter light breezes at N.E.

saw Minke Whales

Friday Oct 28th

Begins with fresh N.E. winds and
cloudy steered S.W. at 4 P.M. saw
two whales chased could not strike
at 6 P.M. strong gales and rain
close reefed the top sails steering S.W.

Middle part more moderate

Latter quite fine made sail
headed to the south saw whales
chased could not faster

Saturday Oct 29th

Begins with fresh N.W. winds and
squally stood to the North saw
whales going quick did not lower
saw two ships took in sail

Middle part fine

Latter the same saw no whales
one ship in sight

Lat 36.21

Long 23.09

Sunday Oct 30th

Begins with light West winds
and fine weather and no whales
Middle part thick cloudy
Latter a gale from the N.W. &
with heavy rain lay too

Monday Oct 31st

Begins with a gale at N.W. & and
heavy rain

Middle part more moderate
made some sail

Latter strong gales at West
and rough sea
