Latter the same saw five whales

Monday Nov 21st
Begins with light West winds and
fine weather saw two whales
Middle part fine
Latter squally Lat 37.43

Tuesday Nov 22nd
Begins with fresh breezes at
N.W. and squally saw one whale
lowered could not fasten three ships
Middle part a gale
Latter part calm saw
whales could not fasten
Lat 35.43

Ground 1836
Wednesday Nov 23rd

Begins calm
Middle part calm
Latter fresh North winds saw
a sperm whale struck and drawn
thick rain with fog

Thursday Nov 24th
Begins with light North winds and
thick fog saw one whale
Middle part thick fog
Latter much the same saw a whale
struck and lost him by cutting the
line through mistake

Friday Nov 25th
Begins with light N.W. winds and
fog with rain
Middle part thick fog
Latter part clear saw a whale
struck and drawn

Nov 25th 35.15
Long 19.36 W

Saturday Nov 26th
Begins with strong breezes
at N.W. and heavy sea steered
South saw nothing took in sail
Middle part gale
Latter the same

Lat 36.07
Long 19.00

Sunday Nov 27th
Begins with a gale at N.W. and
rough sea lay too head to S.E.
Middle part much moderate
Latter fine saw no whales
Lat 35.55
Long 20.25
