August 4th } Commenced with light winds from S. steering S.E. Middle part the same Latter part light airs and Calms employed in breaking out the Bottom Deck. Lat 34. 32 N

Friday

August 5th } Commenced with light airs from W. steering E by S. Middle part the same. Latter part fine breezes from W.W. steering E employed in making spungarn. Lat 34. 24

Saturday

August 6th } Commenced with fine breezes from W.W. steering E. with cloudy weather. Middle part light winds from W. with rain squalls. Latter part light variable winds one sail in sight. Lat 35. 01

Sunday

August 7th } Commenced with light variable winds steering E by N. one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts light airs and Calms. Lowered the Boats twice for Blk Fish, without success. Lat 35. 02

Monday

August 8th } Commenced with light airs from the S. steering E by N. Middle part the same. Latter part wind hauled N.W. Lat 35. 11

Tuesday

August 9th } Commenced with strong breezes from S. steering E by S. at sundown shortened sail for the night and luffed to the Wind. Middle part squally with rain saw a Boat steering S.E. Latter part fresh gales from E.N.E. heading S.E. Lat 35. 20

August 10th } Commenced with strong winds from E.N.E. heading S.E. at 7 P.M. tacked ship to the S. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light airs and Calms. Lat 35. 40 N

Thursday

August 11th } Commenced with calm weather employed in ships duties. Middle part the same. Latter part light breezes from W. steering S. by E. Lat 36. 18

Friday

August 12th } Commenced with light winds from W.W. steering N.E. by E. saw a Boach employed in making spungarn. Middle part squally with rain. Latter part strong winds from N.W.E. heading E. two sail in sight. Lat 37. 38

Saturday

August 13th } Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. steering E.N.E. two sail in sight. Middle part light winds. Latter part fine breezes from W.W. steering E. Lat 38. 30

Sunday

August 14th } Commenced with fine breezes from W. steering E by S. Middle part the same. Latter part fresh gales from same quarter with squally weather. Lat 38. 16

Monday

August 15th } Commenced with fresh gales from W. steering E by S. with squally weather. double reefed top sails. Middle part Calm with rain. Latter part variable winds with fog and rain one sail in sight. Lat 38. 45
