 main topsail and storm sails. Latter
 part more moderate set the top sails
 double reefed bore ship to N.W.

 August 19th Commences with fresh gales from N.W. steering
 E.S.E. with hazy weather. at 4 P.M. saw the
 Island of Corvo. Bearing S.E. by E 12 miles
 distant. bore ship to N.W. Middle part

 Latter part wind from all points of the
 Compass.

 August 20th Commences with calm hazy weather.
 Middle part fresh breezes from N.W. steering
 N.E. Latter part the same the Islands of
 Corvo and Flores in sight ship heading
 N.N.E. 3 sail in sight. Lat 35. 53

Friday
 August 21st Commences with strong breezes from
 N.W. heading N.E. the Land in sight.
 Middle and Latter parts fresh winds
 from N. heading E.S.E. caught several
 fish around a spar Lat 41. 16
 Long 29. 58

Master Outward Passage to the N. Pacific 1863
 Saturday 18th August 20th Commences with fresh breezes from N.
 heading E.S.E. Middle and Latter
 parts the same saw several school of
 Grampuses. Lat 42. 27 58
 Long 28. 16 41

Sunday
 August 21st Commences with fresh breezes from
 N.W. heading N.E. one sail in sight.
 Middle and Latter parts light variable
 winds backed ship several times.
 Lat 43. 30
 Long 27. 42

Monday
 August 22nd Commences with light variable winds
 heading on different tack one sail in
 sight. Middle part the same Latter
 part fresh winds from N.W. steering
 N.E. with thick foggy weather. double
 reefed the top sails Lat 44. 10
 Long 28. 38

Tuesday
 August 23rd Commences with light winds from
 N.W. at 4 P.M. fresh winds from N.W.
 heading N. one sail in sight. Middle
 and Latter parts fresh gales with
 thick foggy weather. Lat 44. 33
 Long 28. 20

Wednesday
 August 24th Commences with fresh gales
 from N.W. heading N.E. with
 thick foggy weather. Middle and
 Latter parts the same. Lat 44. 00
 Long 28. 45

Thursday
 August 25th Commences with fresh gales from
 N.W. heading N.E. Middle part the
 same Latter part more moderate
 set all sail. Lat 43. 15
 Long 29. 45
