September 7th

Commenced with strong winds from S.W. heading N. the Land. and one sail in sight. Middle and Latter part equally with rain and lightning were ship several times. Lat 37. 20 N
Long 28. 50 W

Thursday
Sept 8th

Commenced with strong variable winds heading N. took in the Fore Topsail jib and mainsail. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate were ship to E. the Island of Fayall in sight. Lat 38. 20
Long 29. 20

Friday
Sept 9th

Commenced with strong breezes from N.W. steering S.E. the Islands of Fayall and St. George in sight. Middle part the same Latter part the ship lying off and on Fayall. Discharged 3 fresh men.

Saturday
Sept 10th

Commenced with light winds from N.W. ship lying off and on Fayall at 8 P.M. the Lannet came of with recruits. at 7 the Captain came of ship and 4 Portuguese. Middle part strong winds from N.W. steering S.E. Latter part the same steering S.E. two sail in sight. Lat 37. 15
Long 26. 28

Sunday
Sept 11th

Commenced with strong breezes from N. steering S.E. spoke with Barkham and crew. 28 months and 700 sp. Middle part more moderate Latter part by winds from N.W. two sail in sight. Lat 36. 40
Long 24. 30

Commenced with strong breezes from N.W. steering S.E. with thick rainy weather. Middle and Latter parts the same several sail in sight. Lat 33. 07 N
Long 21. 57 W

Tuesday
Sept 13th

Commenced with fresh gales from E.N.E. steering S.E. at sundown double reefed the Topsails and stuffed by the wind several sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 31. 53
Long 20. 59

Wednesday
Sept 14th

Commenced with fresh gales from E.N.E. heading S.E. at 6 P.M. were ship to N. Middle and Latter parts the same steering S.E. Lat 31. 20
Long 20. 33

Thursday
Sept 15th

Commenced with fresh gales from E.N.E. steering S.E. under double reefed Topsails. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate set all sail. several sail in sight. Lat 28. 57
Long 19. 11

Friday
Sept 16th

Commenced with strong breezes from E.N.E. steering S.E. several sail in sight. at sundown shortened sail. Middle part ship lying aback. Latter part equally at 11 A.M. saw the Island of Ferro. Lat 27. 30
Long 18. 22

Saturday
Sept 17th

Commenced with fresh gales from E.N.E. steering S.E. the Land in sight implied at 10 on the Tigger. Middle and Latter parts the same one sail in sight. Lat 26. 07 N
Long 16. 57 W
