October 26th } Commenced with fresh breezes from N. steering
N. one sail in sight at sundown shortened
sail Middle part ship heading on different
tracks. Latter part fine breezes from N. steering
N.W. Lat 19° 08' S
Long 34° 35' W

Wednesday
Oct 26th } Commenced with light breezes from N.W.
steering N. implied at Rattling the rigging.
Middle part the same. Latter part
variable winds with Rain. Broke out for
Water. Lat 19° 45' S
Long 35° 40' W

Thursday
Oct 27th } Commenced with light winds from S.E.
heading E. S. E. with Rainy weather. Middle
part the same. Latter part light winds from
S.E. heading W. Lat 19° 55' S
Long 35° 46' W

Friday
Oct 28th } Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E.
heading S.W. two sail in sight at 6 P.M. were
ship to E. S. E. Middle part squally with Rain.
Latter part strong gales from S.E. here to
under storm sails. Lat 19° 05' S
Long 35° 05' W

Saturday
Oct 29th } Commenced with strong gales from S.E. with
Rain heading E. S. E. under storm sails.
Middle part the same. Latter part more
moderate with Rain squalls. Exchanged
signalls with a English Brig. Lat 18° 30' S
Long 35° 45' W

Sunday
Oct 30th } Commenced with fresh gales from S.E. heading
E. S. E. with Rain squalls at 8 P.M. were ship to
S.W. Middle and Latter part the same
several sail in sight. Lat 18° 16' S
Long 35° 16' W

Monday 1833
October 31st } Commenced with strong winds from N.W. heading
S.W. with Rain squalls. Several sail in sight
Middle part the same. Latter part more
moderate made all sail. Lat 19° 54' S
Long 36° 18' W

Tuesday
Nov 1st } Commenced with fine breezes from S.E.
heading S.W. with all sail set. one sail in sight
Middle part the same. Latter part plenty of
Humpbacks in sight. Lowered for them without
success. Lat 21° 00' S
Long 37° 08' W

Wednesday
Nov 2nd } Commenced with light breezes from S.E.
steering S.W. plenty of Humpbacks, and two
sail in sight. Middle part the same. Latter
part fine breezes from E. S. E. with pleasant
weather. Lat 23° 00' S
Long 38° 19' W

Thursday
Nov 3rd } Commenced with fine breezes from S.E.
steering S.W. Middle part the same.
Latter part strong gales from N.E. don't
recall the topsails unbent the fore sail
and repaired it. Lat 25° 30' S
Long 39° 50' W

Friday
Nov 4th } Commenced with fresh gales from N.
steering S.W. Middle and Latter part
fresh breezes from S.W. heading S.E. Lat 26° 00' S
Long 39° 10' W

Saturday
Nov 5th } Commenced with fresh breezes from
heading S.E. at sundown shortened sail
set the Watch in boats crew. Middle and
Latter part the same heading S.W.
Lat 26° 23' S
Long 39° 53' W
