November 6th Commences with fresh breezes from E.S.E. steering S.W. at sundown shortened sail. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. steering S.W. Lat 27.24 S Long 41.05 W

Monday

Nov 7th Commences with fine breezes from N.W. steering S.W. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. sail in sight Lat 28.52 Long 42.23

Tuesday

Nov 8th Commences with fresh breezes from N.W. steering S.W. sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. with heavy weather. Lat 30.40 Long 44.13

Wednesday

Nov 9th Commences with fresh breezes from S.W. heading S.E. with heavy weather. Exchanged signals with an English ship. Middle part calm. Latter part fresh breezes from S.W. Lat 31.40 Long 45.00

Thursday

Nov 10th Commences with strong gales from S.W. here to. under storm sails at 4 P.M. here ship to N.W. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light airs and calm. Lat 32.00 Long 46.00

Friday

Nov 11th Commences with light breezes from E. steering S.W. at sundown shortened sail. Middle part strong breezes from N. Latter part strong gales with rain. Lat 33.07 Long 47.45

Saturday

Nov 12th Commences with fresh gales from N.W. heading S.W. under storm sails. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breezes from S.W. heading S.E. send down the Warren top gallant and main royal yards one sail in sight. Lat 34.00 S Long 46.30 W

November 13th Commences with strong breezes from N.W. heading S.W. Middle and Latter parts strong gales from N.W. with a heavy swell. Lat 35.36 S Long 48.42 W

Monday

Nov 14th Commences with fresh gales from N.W. heading S.W. under storm sails. Middle and Latter parts strong gales from N.W. heading S.W. Lat 36.00 S Long 49.00

Tuesday

Nov 15th Commences with fresh gales from N.W. heading S.W. under storm sails. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light winds from E. steering S.W. Lat 35.40 Long 49.32

Wednesday

Nov 16th Commences with strong breezes from N.W. steering S.W. send down the Warren top gallant yard. Middle part the same. Latter part fresh gales from N. Lat 36.00 S Long 47.00

Thursday

Nov 17th Commences with fresh gales from N. steering S.W. with heavy weather. Caught two Porpoises. Middle part light winds from N.E. with rain. Latter part fresh breezes from E.S.E. Lat 37.35 Long 48.40

Friday

Nov 18th Commences with strong gales from S.E. heading S.W. under storm sails. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate one sail in sight. Lat 38.00 Long 49.20

Saturday

Nov 19th Commences with fresh breezes from E.S.E. steering S.W. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 39.18 Long 51.37
