Sunday 1884

January 1<sup>st</sup> Commences with variable winds with squally weather. heading S to SW several sail in sight. Middle part light airs from E steering NW. Latter part variable winds with squally weather several sail in sight Lat 56. 30 S Long 67. 35 W

Monday

Jan 2<sup>d</sup> Commences with fresh gales from N steering SW with squally weather several sail in sight. Borend to the Westward Middle part fresh gales from SW heading NW. Latter part variable winds Lat 58. 00 Long 69. 26

Tuesday

Jan 3<sup>d</sup> Commences with fresh gales from NW heading S with squally weather at 4 P.M. Tacked ship to NW several sail in sight. Middle part the same Latter part variable winds heading on different tacks & exchanged signals with Shipper Ship. Eagle Lat 57. 50 Long 70. 50

Wednesday

Jan 4<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh breezes from SW heading NW several sail in sight. Middle part the same Latter part wind tanted W Tacked ship to SW Lat 57. 20 Long 72. 00

Thursday

Jan 5<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from NW heading S with thick. Rainy weather. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate wind hauled S. Tacked ship to NW Lat 57. 50 Long 75. 42

Friday

Jan 6<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from steering NW under close reefed topsails and courses on sail in sight. Middle part more moderate Latter part fresh gales from SW steering NW with squally weather Lat 56. 50 Long 77. 15

January 7<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from steering NW with squally weather. Middle and Latter parts squally Lat 56. 00 S Long 78. 40 W

Sunday

Jan 8<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from SW heading NW with squally weather. Middle part variable winds bore ship to SW. Latter part fresh breeze from NW. Tacked ship to SW Lat 52. 40 Long 79. 40

Monday

Jan 9<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from NW heading SW under double reefed topsails with thick weather. Middle and Latter parts variable winds with thick weather. Lat 51. 21 Long 79. 52

Tuesday

Jan 10<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from NW heading SW with thick weather. Middle part Rainy Latter part strong gales from S with squally weather and hail. Lat 49. 50 Long 80. 07

Wednesday

Jan 11<sup>th</sup> Commences with strong gales from steering NW under close reefed 3 and main topsails with heavy squalls and hail. Middle part light winds from steering W. Latter part variable winds several Fairbanks in sight. Lat 48. 28 Long 81. 32

Thursday

Jan 12<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh breezes from W heading NW at 6 P.M. Tacked ship to SW. Caught a Porpoise. Middle and Latter parts foggy with strong winds from W. Lat 48. 45 Long 82. 15

Friday

Jan 13<sup>th</sup> Commences with fresh gales from NW heading S with foggy weather. Middle and Latter parts the same Lat 49. 20 Long 85. 00
