N.W. at 1 P.M. saw a school of Bk Fish. the
Boat and Boat Stow and saved two.
Middle part Rain. Latter part fresh gales from
S.W. heading on different tacks. Lat 28. 30

Monday
Jan 23rd } Commences with fresh gales from S.W. heading
N.W. under short sail. Middle part squally
Latter part steering N.W. Lat 26. 00
Long 76. 21

Tuesday
Jan 24th } Commences with fresh breezes from S.W. heading
on different tacks. one sail in sight. Middle
part the same. Latter part fine breezes from S.W.
the Enagatca Islands in sight. Bearing E by N
Compass at 7 A.M. tacked ship to N.W. Berthed the
