 Blk Fish. Middle part fresh breezes from S.E.
 Latter part fresh breezes from E heading on
 opposite tacks. Lat 41. 58' S
 Long 78. 18 W

Saturday
 Jan 28th } Commences with fresh breezes from S.E.
 heading S.E. with Pleasant weather. saw a school
 of Blk Fish. Middle part the same Latter part
 fresh breezes from S.E. heading S at 9 P.M. saw
 the Island of Shiloh. Bearing E by compass. on
 sail in sight Lat 41. 56

Sunday
 Jan 29th } Commences with fresh breezes from S the Land
 in sight Bearing E. ship heading on opposite
 tacks. got up the cables and got the anchors of
 the Bows Middle part ship heading on different
 tacks and lying about Latter part light air
 and Calm. the Land in sight. No Observations

Monday
 Jan 30th } Commences with variable winds ship heading
 on different tacks with heavy Rain weather on
 sail in sight. Middle part light air and Calm
 Latter part light variable winds ship heading in for
 the Land Lat 41. 56

Tuesday
 Jan 31st } Commences with light variable winds ship heading
 of and on the Land. with heavy weather. the Land
 Bearing E on sail in sight. Middle part light
 air and Calm with Rain heading of and on the
 Land Latter part light variable winds heading
 in for the Land with heavy weather
 Lat 41. 46

Wednesday 1864 }
 February 1st } Commences with fine breezes from S.W. heading
 in for the Land. with cloudy weather at 8 P.M.
 Come to an anchor in 7 fathoms of Water in
 St. Carlos Roads.

Wednesday
 Feb 2nd } Commences with fine breezes from S.W. at 8 P.M.
 got under weigh in company with ship splendid
 and stood out of the Harbor at 7. Come to an
 anchor again. two men Jacob Mayo and Joel
 Pangborn stole a Boat from alongside belonging to
 the splendid and run away Middle and Latter
 parts lying at an anchor.

Thursday
 Feb 23rd } Commences with light variable winds with
 thick weather. middle part the same. at 8 P.M. took
 our anchor and stood out of the Harbor. in
 company with ship splendid.

Friday
 Feb 24th } Commences with fresh breezes from S.W. steering
 N.W. in company with ship splendid. ship with
 ship Robert Edwards of New Bedford. Middle and
 Latter parts variable wind Lat 40. 56
 Long 76. 30 W

Saturday
 Feb 25th } Commences with fresh variable winds steering N
 N.W. in company with ship splendid on sail in
 sight. Middle and Latter parts equally set the fore
 topmast studding sail Lat 37. 28
 Long 78. 00

Sunday
 Feb 26th } Commences with fresh breezes from S.W. steering N.W.
 with heavy weather. in company with ship splendid
 Middle and Latter parts the same several sail in
 sight
 Lat 34. 36
 Long 79. 30
