Friday 28th } Commenced with light breezes from N.W. heading  
N.W. Middle part snow squalls. Latter part fresh  
breezes from N.W. heading on different to the one sail  
and plenty of Fin. Backs in sight. Lat 44..40

Saturday 29th } Commenced with light breezes from N.W. heading  
on different to the one sail and plenty of Fin. Backs  
in sight. Middle part light airs and Calms

Wednesday May 3rd } Commenced with strong winds from S. steering  
N.W. at 6 P.M. saw several Right whales. at  
sundown shortened sail. Middle and Latter part  
more moderate with snow squalls. found the same  
mast rotten. Lat 52..36  
Long 166..50

Thursday May 4th } Commenced with light winds from S. heading  
N.W. with snow squalls saw several Right  
whales going quick. Middle and Latter part  
fresh breezes Lat 52..52  
Long 166..20

Friday May 5th } Commenced with fresh breezes from N. heading  
N.W. at 4 P.M. saw several N.W. saw ship to  
N.W. Middle and Latter part variable  
winds with plenty of snow. Lat 53..20  
Long 166..29

Saturday May 6th } Commenced with fine variable winds heading  
on different to the one sail. Middle and Latter part
