Wednesday June 14th } Commences with fresh breezes from N.E. heading of and on the Land. Cape Thadens Bearing N.W. Plenty of Ice. and several sail in sight. Middle part ship steering S with thick fog. Latter part ship heading in for Cape Saveren. spoke with Lewis of New Bedford. Lat 62° 10' N Long 179° 00' E

Thursday June 15th } Commences with light breezes from E steering S with thick foggy weather. Spoke with ship Lewis. Middle part Calm. Latter part light variable winds several sail in sight Cape Saveren. Bearing N.W. Distance 40 miles. Lat 61° 27' Long 178° 50'

Friday June 16th } Commences with light airs and Calms. several sail and the Ice in sight. Coming with the Lewis Middle and Latter part light airs and Calm with thick foggy weather. Lat 61° 30' Long 178° 30'

Saturday June 17th } Commences with light airs and Calm. with thick foggy weather. 10 sail and the Ice in sight. Middle and Latter part light variable winds with hazy weather. spoke with ship George Washington of Warham. Lat 61° 26' Long 178° 30'

Sunday June 18th } Commences with light variable winds with thick hazy weather. 10 sail and the Ice in sight. spoke with ship Illinois. of New Bedford. Middle part ship going about. Latter part light breeze from S ship heading N. several sail and the Land in sight. Lat 61° 00' Long 178° 00'

Monday June 19th } Commences with light breezes from S heading N.W. several sail and the Ice in sight. spoke with ship Illinois and Lewis of New Bedford. Middle and Latter part fresh breezes from S heading S with thick weather. Lat 60° 57' N Long 176° 00' E

Tuesday June 20th } Commences with fresh breezes from E.S. with thick foggy weather. ship heading S in company with ship Illinois. Middle and Latter part fresh breezes from N.E. heading E. three sail in sight. Lat 60° 20' Long 177° 26'

Wednesday June 21th } Commences with fresh breezes from N.E. heading in different tracks with Raining weather. spoke with ship Illinois. Middle part fresh gales from E.S. heading S. Latter part strong gales from E.S. heading S.E. double reefed the top sails. Lat 59° 27' Long 177° 30'

Thursday June 22th } Commences with strong gales from N.E. heading E.S. with thick Raining weather. More reefed the top sails. double reefed the fore and main sails. and fift red sails. spoke Middle and Latter part fresh gales from E.S. heading S under double reefed top sails and courses. Lat 58° 00' Long 176° 30'

Friday June 23th } Commences with fresh gales from E.S. heading S. under double reefed top sails and courses with thick Raining weather. spoke with ship Illinois. Middle part more moderate. Latter part fresh breezes from N.E. heading E. Lat 57° 41' Long 176° 00'

Saturday June 24th } Commences with fresh breezes from N.W. steering E with Raining weather. spoke with ship Illinois. Middle and Latter part fresh gales from N.W. steering E by S with Raining weather. Lat 57° 20' Long 179° 30' E
