Latter part strong gales from N. E. steering S. W. with thick rainy weather. at 10 AM. Passed Cape Horn. Lat 63. 13 N Long 177. 27 W

Sept 10th } Commences with fresh gales from N. E. steering S. W. in company with ship. Minnie several sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts more moderate steered the Anchor and Chain. Lat 62. 16 N Long 176. 20 W

Sept 11th } Commences with strong winds from N. E. steering S. W. with heavy weather in company with ship. Minnie. Middle and Latter parts moderate. Lat 59. 35 N Long 186. 00 W

Sept 15th } Commences with fresh breeze from S. W. heading S. W. employed reefing the main sail two sail in sight at 4 PM were ship to S. E. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate with fog squalls. Lat 58. 30 N Long 176. 36 W

Saturday
