Thursday 20th } Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. heading East with cloudy weather. Middle and Latter part fresh gales with heavy squalls and continual rain. Ship lying under storn middle. Lat 36. 06 Long 108. 30

Friday 21st } Commenced with fresh gales from S.E. heading S.W. with squally weather and rain. ship under storn sails. Middle and Latter part the same with heavy squalls. Lat 36. 07 Long 108. 22

Saturday 22nd } Commenced with fresh gale from S.E. heading S.W. with squally weather. Middle part the same. Latter part moderate breeze top mast. Do not stay Parted. Lat 36. 30 Long 108. 22

Sunday 23rd } Commenced with strong breezes from S.E. heading S.W. Middle and Latter part the same with squally weather. Lat 33. 33 Long 108. 28

Monday 24th } Commenced with strong winds from S. heading S.W. Middle and Latter part the same employed repairing sails. Lat 31. 20 Long 108. 20

Wednesday 19th } Commenced with light breezes from S.E. heading S.E. with all sails set. Middle and Latter part squally weather. A arrived away the 24th 5th Broom. Lat 28. 18 Long 103. 00

Thursday 20th } Commenced with moderate breezes from N.E. steering S.E. with squally weather. Middle and Latter part the same sent out the 24th 5th Broom. Lat 27. 18 Long 101. 28

Friday 21st } Commenced with moderate breezes from S.E. steering S.E. found the fore topmast sprung sent down the fore top gallant yard and mast. Middle and Latter part light winds sent down the fore topmast. Lat 26. 17 Long 101. 08

Saturday 22nd } Commenced with light winds from N.E. steering S.E. all hands employed setting a new fore topmast and rigging. Middle and Latter part the same sent up the fore topmast and top gallant mast and set up the rigging. Lat 26. 25 Long 100. 20

Sunday 23rd } Commenced with light winds from S.E. heading S.E. Middle and Latter part variable winds and squally. Lat 23. 04 Long 100. 22
