at 3 A.M. saw Peter's Island Lat 25. 108

Sunday
March 4th Commenced with light breezes from E.S.E.

Ship looking up to Peter's Island Middle
and latter parts ship. Lying of anchor
at 8 A.M. the Captain went ashore

Monday
March 5th Commenced with light winds from E.S.E.

Ship lying of anchor on Peter's Island as
6 P.M. the Captain came up and studied N.
N.W. Middle and latter parts fresh
breezes from E. at 5 A.M. saw Martha's and
Bonds Islands found them to be lapped
down 15 miles to far West. Lat 23. 23

March 6th Commenced with fresh breezes from E.S.E.

steering N.W. by N. Middle and latter
parts the same Lat 20. 21

Wednesday
March 7th Commenced with fresh breezes from

E.S.E. steering N.W. by N. employed at
work on the rigging Middle and latter
parts light breezes from E. employed
setting up water pipes and work on
the rigging Lat 17. 16

March 8th Commenced with light breezes from N.W.
steering N.W. by N. Middle and latter parts
light variable winds. Lat 16. 18

Friday
March 9th Commenced with light wind from N.

heading N.W. Middle and latter parts variable
winds and squally. Lat 15. 17

Saturday
March 10th Commenced with light variable winds ship

heading to Westward Middle and latter
parts the same Lat 14. 26

Sunday
March 11th Commenced with variable winds and

squally with Rain steering N.W. by N.
Middle and latter parts the same took
several Lunar observations. Lat 13. 25

Monday
March 12th Commenced with variable winds and

squally steering N.W. by N. Middle and latter
parts the same Lat 11. 15

Tuesday
March 13th Commenced with light winds from E.S.E.

steering N.W. by N. Middle and latter
parts squally Lat 10. 20

Wednesday
March 14th Commenced with fresh variable winds

steering N.W. saw a part of the Marquesas
Group of Islands Middle and latter
parts squally ship steering for the
Land (Tahiti Island) Lat 8. 15
