April 14th Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. ship going of and on Honolulu at 5 P.M. the Captain came of and steered N.W. Middle and Latter part the same steering N. Lat 22. 15 N Long 158. 30 W

April 15th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. heading N.W. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat 25. 50 Long 163. 20

April 21st Commenced with fresh breezes from N heading on different tracks Middle and Latter part the same. Lat 30. 00 Long 168. 25

Friday
April 22nd Commenced with moderate breezes from N heading on different tracks. Middle and Latter part fine breezes from N.E. heading N.W. repaired the mainmast. Lat 31. 15 Long 168. 21

Saturday
April 23rd Commenced with fine breezes from N.E. heading N. Middle and Latter part high airs and Calms. Lat 33. 00 Long 168. 20

Sunday
April 24th Commenced with light airs from N.E. heading N.W. Middle and Latter part much the same with fine weather. Lat 32. 06 Long 169. 01

April 25th Commenced with fine breezes from N.E. heading N.W. Middle and Latter part the same. employed repairing sails with Pleasant weather. Lat 36. 40 Long 168. 56
