Friday June 1st Commenced with fresh breezes from E. & S. heading N.E. one sail in sight. Middle and Latter part fog and rain. Lat 56. 30 N Long 146. 00

Saturday June 2nd Commenced with strong winds from N.E. heading E. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from E. one sail in sight. Lat 56. 50 N Long 145. 12

Sunday June 3rd Commenced with fine breezes from S. steering E. by N. one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts hazy with fog. Lat 58. 50 N Long 141. 45

Monday June 4th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. heading E. in company with Bark Candace of New London, Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes and rain. Lat 57. 18 N Long 139. 00

Tuesday June 5th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. heading N.E. one sail in sight. saw several birds at 1 P.M. saw land. bearing N.E. 10 miles distant. at 1 made all sail and steered S. Middle part strong winds from N.E. Latter part fresh breezes from N.E. steering N.W. at 10 A.M. saw several Right Whales at 11 sail and Luffed by the wind with Rainy weather. Lat 57. 00 N Long 146. 00

Wednesday June 6th Commenced with strong Gale from N.W. with thick Rainy weather. Middle part more moderate. Latter part Calm with thick fog. Lat 56. 40 N Long 143. 50

Thursday June 7th Commenced with calm foggy weather. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 57. 00 N Long 143. 10 W

Friday June 8th Commenced with light breezes from N.W. and fog. two sails in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from S.E. several sail in sight. spoke with ship Liverpool & Whales this season saw a Right Whale. Covered without success. Lat 57. 29 N Long 145. 20

Saturday June 9th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. steering N. several sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts light winds from S. Lat 58. 00 N Long 145. 20

Sunday June 10th Commenced with light airs and Calms. saw the Liverpool take a Whale. Middle part the same. Latter part fine breezes from N.W. Lat 58. 22 N Long 145. 12

Monday June 11th Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. heading N.W. saw Rose Island. bearing S. by N. 20 miles distant. Middle and Latter parts the same. Plenty of Pin Pinks in sight. Lat 58. 00 N Long 145. 27

Tuesday June 12th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading on different tack. spoke with ship Erie. Whales, Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. Lat 58. 20 N Long 146. 00

Wednesday June 13th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading S.E. several sail in sight. at 1 P.M. Covered for a Right Whale at 1 P.M. the Harbour steved at 9 P.M. Calm here and at 10 P.M. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. saw two Right Whales going quick. Covered without success. Lat 58. 14 N Long 146. 27
