June 19th Commenced with fresh breezes from E. heading different courses several sail in sight Middle and Latter parts Begg Lat 58. 00 Long 148. 30

Saturday

June 20th Commenced with light winds from E. following N.W. with Begg weather. Middle and Latter parts Calm. Lat 58. 28 Long 148. 20

Sunday

June 21st Commenced with Calm Begg weather. Middle and Latter parts light winds and Begg Lat 58. 30 Long 148. 00

Monday

June 22nd Commenced with fine breezes from E. with Begg and Rain. Middle and Latter parts strong winds from E. Lat 58. 55 Long 148. 30

Tuesday

June 23rd Commenced with strong winds from E. with thick weather. Middle and Latter parts fresh Bales from E. Lat 58. 55 Long 148. 15

Wednesday

June 24th Commenced with fresh Bales from E. heading on different tack with Rainy weather. Middle part more moderate sea. Rose Island 8 miles distant. Latter part strong winds from E. Lat 58. 23 Long 147. 00

Thursday

June 25th Commenced with fresh Bales from E. steering S.W. Middle and Latter parts equally with Rain and Begg. Lat 57. 21 Long 149. 40

Friday 18th

June 22nd Commenced with strong winds from E. with Rain and Begg. Middle and Latter parts more moderate sea on sail. Lat 57. 38 N Long 148. 30 W

Saturday

June 23rd Commenced with fresh breezes from E. with thick weather heading N.W. spoke with Bark James Andrews of New Bedford 1 Whale. Middle and Latter parts Calm. Lat 58. 00 Long 148. 00

Sunday

June 24th Commenced with light air and Calm sun. Several Blump backs. the James Andrews in Company. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. Lat 58. 28 Long 148. 20

Monday

June 25th Commenced with strong winds from N.W. heading N.W. spoke with ship. Several parts strong winds from N.W. saw a Right Whale. Several and others without success. Lat 58. 45 Long 148. 30

Tuesday

June 26th Commenced with strong winds from N.W. heading on different tacks. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 58. 55 Long 148. 55

Wednesday

June 27th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.W. with thick heavy weather. Middle and Latter parts more moderate. Several for Whales without success. the Land in sight. Lat 58. 30 Long 148. 50

Thursday

June 28th Commenced with Calm weather. the Land in sight. Several for Whales without success. Middle and Latter parts light winds from N. heading on for the Land on sail in sight. saw him take a Whale. Montague Island 25 miles distant. Lat 59. 10 Long 148. 20
