June 29th Commenced with fine breezes from N.W.
heading in for Montague Island. one sail
in sight. Several got bottom with 70 fathoms
touch of shore. Middle and latter parts light
airs and Calm. Covered for Whales going quick
without success. Lat 59. 13 N
Long 148. 11 W

Saturday
June 30th Commenced with light airs and Calm. Montague
Island Baring N. one sail in sight saw several
Whales going quick. Middle and latter part
Calm. Plenty of Whales in sight. The Bow Boat
struck and lost the line. Lat 59. 10
Long 148. 20

Sunday
July 1st Commenced with light airs and Calm. 3
Plenty of Whales in sight. Covered without success
Montague. Island Baring N.E. Middle and
latter parts light airs and Calm. The Harbour
Boat went on and missed the Whales.
Lat 59. 18
Long 148. 11

Monday
July 2nd Commenced with light winds from N.E. plenty
of Whales in sight. The Bow Boat striking the
Bow Boat struck and drove the Land and
one sail in sight. Middle and latter parts fresh
breezes from N.E. and equally. Lat 59. 12
Long 148. 30

Tuesday
July 3rd Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. and
equally the Land in sight. Ship heading on
different tack. Middle and latter parts strong
breezes from N.E. with rain. Lat 59. 18
Long 148. 18

Wednesday
July 4th Commenced with strong breezes from N. heading
on different tack. The Land in sight. Middle and
latter parts light winds from N. steering along the
Land to N.E. saw several Whales going quick.
Lat 58. 58
Long 148. 29

Thursday 1883

July 5th Commenced with fine breezes from N. steering
along the Land to N.E. one sail in sight. Middle
and latter parts light breezes from N. at 11 AM
the Bow Boat struck a Whale. Lat 59. 30 N
Long 148. 11 W

Friday
July 6th Commenced with fine breezes from N.E. the Bow
boat to the Whale. The Bow Boat line parted. The
Bow Boat got stove and cut line. The Harbour
Boat missed the Harbour Boat struck and
dressed Montague. Island Baring N. one sail
in sight. Middle part strong winds
and rain. Latter part light winds and
Calm. Lat 59. 11
Long 148. 55

Saturday
July 7th Commenced with light winds and Calm.
one sail and the Land in sight. Several
Whales going quick. Middle and latter part
the same. Several sail in sight. Lat 59. 10
Long 148. 11

Sunday
July 8th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E.
heading on different tack. Several sail and the
Land in sight. Middle and latter part fresh
gales from N.E. with rain. Lat 59. 13
Long 148. 55

Monday
July 9th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E.
ship heading on different tack. Middle and
latter parts the same. Lat 59. 15
Long 148. 30

Tuesday
July 10th Commenced with fresh gales from N.E. ship
heading on different tack. Several sail and
Plenty of Whales in sight. Middle and latter
parts the same. spoke with Bark James
Anderson 3 Whales
Lat 59. 11
Long 148. 21
