Nov 13th Commenced with strong winds from N. heading N.E. Middle and Latter parts employed Boiling

Thursday 14th

Nov 14th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading N. at 8 P.M. finished Boiling. Middle and Latter parts the same

Friday 15th

Nov 15th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.E. Middle and Latter parts the same heading on different tacks

Saturday 16th

Dec 1st Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. heading in different tacks. Middle and Latter parts light airs and Calms saw a school of Blk Fish. Landed and got two of them

Sunday 17th

Dec 12th Commenced with light airs and Calms Landed for Blk Fish without success. Middle and Latter parts the same.

Monday 18th

Dec 18th Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. heading N. Middle and Latter parts the same the Maria Islands and the Coast of Mexico in sight

Dec 19th Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. heading N. the Maria Islands, and the Coast in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same.

Wednesday 20th

Dec 20th Commenced with light breezes from N.W. heading N. the Maria Islands in sight. Middle and Latter parts Calm and light airs

Thursday 21st

Dec 21st Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.E. employed steering. Oil & one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same

Friday 22nd

Dec 22nd Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. heading N. one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes.

Saturday 23rd

Dec 23rd Commenced with light winds and Calms. Middle and Latter parts squally with Rain

Sunday 24th

Dec 24th Commenced with strong breezes from N.W. heading N. double reefed the top sails. Middle part the same Latter part more moderate at 7 A.M. saw Cape St. Lucas.

Monday 25th

Dec 25th Commenced with light airs and Calms ship of Cape St. Lucas. Middle and Latter parts the same saw two steamers

Tuesday 26th

Dec 26th Commenced with light variable winds ship of Cape St. Lucas one sail and a steamer in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same.

Wednesday 27th

Dec 27th Commenced with light airs and Calms ship of Cape St. Lucas. Middle and Latter parts fine breezes from N.W.
