Commences with strong winds from E. S. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. employed steering. Did in the fore hold. Lat 21. 16. Long 132. 00.

Friday Feb 22nd

Commences with fresh gales from E. S. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 28. Long 136. 00.

Saturday Feb 23rd

Commences with fresh gales from E. S. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 28. Long 137. 40.

Sunday Feb 24th

Commences with fresh gales from E. S. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 28. Long 140. 00.

Monday Feb 25th

Commences with fresh gales from E. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 28. Long 143. 30.

Tuesday Feb 26th

Commences with fresh gales from E. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 20. Long 146. 25.

Wednesday Feb 27th

Commences with strong winds from E. S. steering N. Middle part the same. Latter part variable winds and calms with fair. Lat 21. 50. Long 148. 00.

Thursday Feb 28th

Commences with light winds from E. steering N. Middle and Latter part the same. Lat 21. 22. Long 149. 09.

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Monday Feb 29th

Commences with light airs from E. S. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 45. N. Long 150. 02. W.

Tuesday March 1st

Commences with light breezes from E. S. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 20. Long 151. 32.

Wednesday March 2nd

Commences with fine breezes from E. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 21. 23. Long 152. 00.

Thursday March 3rd

Commences with fine breezes from E. steering N. Middle and Latter parts the same. at 7 A.M. saw the Island of Moore. Bearing S. by W. Lat 21. 20. Long 156. 00.

Friday March 4th

Commences with fresh breezes from E. steering N. by N. the Islands of Moore and Moorea in sight. got the anchors of the Boats Middle part the same. Latter part calm. two sail in sight. at 6 A.M. saw Oahu.

Saturday March 5th

Commences with light airs and calms the Islands of Moorea and Oahu in sight. two sails in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same. dimmed head bearing N. W. 20 miles distant. 7 sail in sight.

Sunday March 6th

Commences with light airs and calms the Islands of Moorea, Raii and Oahu in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same. at 8 A.M. the Captain went ashore.

Monday March 7th

Commences with light variable winds ship of Honolulu harbor. at 4 P.M. the steamer took us in tow and towed us inside of the reef.
