Middle and Latter parts equally with snow steering E
by S. Lat 52° 20' N
Long 147° 32' E

Sunday

Oct 5th Commenced with strong winds from N.W. steering E
by S. with squally weather. Middle part the same. Latter part
light winds, on sail in sight. Lat 52° 23'

Monday

Oct 6th Commenced with light airs and Calms on sail in sight
Middle and Latter parts fresh gales from S. heading E by S
Lat 52° 14'

Tuesday

Oct 7th Commenced with strong gales from S. heading N.W. under
storm sails. Middle and Latter parts strong gales from
N.W. steering E. Lat 51° 28'

Wednesday

Oct 8th Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. steering E by S.
Middle and Latter parts fresh gales from S. heading
Lat 51° 39'

Thursday

Oct 9th Commenced with strong gales from S. heading
N.W. under storm sails. Middle part the same. Latter
part fresh gales from S. heading E by S
Lat 51° 30'
Long 150° 56'

Oct 10th Commenced with fresh gales from S. heading E by S under storm
sails. Middle and Latter parts fresh gales from N.W. at 8 A.M. saw
Chama Island. Bearing E by E. Lat 51° 12'

Saturday

Oct 11th Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. heading N.W.
Middle and Latter parts more moderate and squally
heading on different tracks. Lat 51° 12'

Sunday

Oct 12th Commenced with light winds and Calms. Three of
the Revell Islands in sight. put a new fore top sail.
Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from N.W. steering
E by S. Lat 51° 13'

Monday

Oct 13th Commenced with fine breezes from N.W. steering E.
bore of the Revell Islands in sight. at 2 P.M. passed
Rauken Islands and started. E by S. Middle and
Latter parts fine breezes from N.W. Lat 51° 50'

Tuesday

Oct 14th Commenced with fresh breezes from S. steering E
Middle part fresh gales from N.W. Latter part heavy gales
from same quarter heading E under main top
and fore top mast staysail. Lat 51° 20'

Wednesday

Oct 15th Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. at 3 P.M. the
fore and main top sails close reefed and started. E.
Middle and Latter part the same. Lat 51° 00'

Thursday

Oct 16th Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. steering E by S.
Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate on sail in
sight. Lat 51° 55'

Friday

Oct 17th Commenced with light breezes from S. steering E. on sail
in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh gales from
S. heading E by E with heavy weather
