Oct 18th Commenced with fresh gales from S.W. steering E.S.E. one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh gales from N.W. Lat 17 - 18 N Long 112 - 54 W

Sunday

Oct 19th Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. steering E.S.E. with squally weather one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 18 - 17 N Long 111 - 00

Monday

Oct 20th Commenced with strong breezes from N.W. steering E.S.E. with squally weather one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts more moderate. spoke with ship Corinthian of New Bedford. Lat 18 - 12 N Long 119 - 55 W

Tuesday

Oct 21st Commenced with fine breeze from N.W. steering E.S.E. two sail in sight. sent the fore and mizzen top gallant yards aloft. Middle and Latter parts light variable winds sent the main Royal yard aloft. Lat 18 - 02 N Long 119 - 20

Wednesday

Oct 22nd Commenced with light winds from E. heading S.S.E. three sail in sight. sent the studding sails. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from E.S.E. Lat 18 - 27 N Long 117 - 30

Thursday

Oct 23rd Commenced with strong breezes from E.S.E. heading S.S.E. one sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh gales from E. Lat 18 - 00 N Long 111 - 00

Friday

Oct 24th Commenced with fresh gales from E. heading S.S.E. pitched the fly jib boom and fore Royal mast away. Middle and Latter parts the same with Rain. Lat 18 - 30 N Long 116 - 00

Saturday

Oct 25th Commenced with fresh gales from E. heading S.S.E. without wind. Middle and Latter parts more moderate with Rain and Hazy. Lat 18 - 00 N Long 116 - 00

Oct 19th Commenced with light winds from E.S.E. heading S.E. with Rain. Middle part fresh gales from E. Latter part strong gales from N.W. steering E.S.E. under close reefed Band Main & Topsails. Lat 18 - 20 N Long 113 - 35

Monday

Oct 20th Commenced with strong gales from N.W. steering E.S.E. under close reefed Band main & Topsails at 10 o'clock sent the Starboard boat and Coxswain. Latter part more moderate. one sail in sight. Lat 18 - 20 N Long 110 - 25

Tuesday

Oct 21st Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. steering E.S.E. one sail in sight. Middle part variable winds. Latter part fresh gales from S. steering E.S.E. Lat 18 - 10 N Long 107 - 30

Wednesday

Oct 22nd Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. steering E.S.E. Middle part moderate. Latter part fresh gales from S.W. with Rain. Lat 18 - 10 N Long 104 - 15

Thursday

Oct 23rd Commenced with fresh gales from N.W. steering E.S.E. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate. Lat 18 - 30 N Long 100 - 30
