Nov 1st Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. heading E Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 30' W

Sunday

Nov 2nd Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. heading E Middle and Latter parts squally. Lat 13° 15' N Long 156° 20' W

Monday

Nov 3rd Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. heading S.W. more sail in sight. Middle part variable winds Latter part Calm. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 15' W

Tuesday

Nov 4th Commenced with light winds and Calms two sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from S.E. Hope with ship of decline. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Wednesday

Nov 5th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. with rain heading S.W. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezes from S.E. steering S.E. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Thursday

Nov 6th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. steering S.E. Two sail in sight. Middle part squally. Latter part more moderate. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Friday

Nov 7th Commenced with fine breezes from S.E. steering S.E. Two sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts light airs and Calms. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Saturday

Nov 8th Commenced with light winds from S.E. steering S.E. Two sail in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part strong winds from S.E. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Sunday

Nov 9th Commenced with strong winds from S.E. steering S.E. with squally weather. Middle and Latter parts the same. Two sail in sight. Lat 13° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Monday 1863

Nov 10th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. steering S.W. with squally weather. Two sail in sight. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 22° 25' N Long 156° 40' W

Tuesday

Nov 11th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. steering S.W. with thick squally weather. at 9 P.M. saw the Island of Oahu. Middle part ship. Lying ahead. Latter part steering for Honolulu. at 10 P.M. the Captain went ashore.

Wednesday

Nov 12th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. ship. Lying off and on Honolulu. the Captain ashore. Middle part ship. off and on. Latter part the same. at 10 P.M. the steamer towed us inside the reef.

Thursday

Nov 13th Commenced with pleasant weather. at 4 P.M. the Pilot took us outside the Reef. Middle and Latter part strong winds from S.E. Lat 19° 00' N

Friday

Nov 14th Commenced with strong winds from S.E. steering S.E. Middle and Latter parts the same and squally. Lat 15° 00' N Long 156° 00' W

Saturday

Nov 15th Commenced with fresh gales from S.E. steering S.E. Middle and Latter parts more moderate. Lat 13° 00' N Long 157° 40' W

Sunday

Nov 16th Commenced with fine breezes from S.E. heading S.E. Middle and Latter parts squally with rain. Lat 11° 00' N Long 157° 30' W
