 light air from W. steering S. W. on a wind at 4 o'clock
 ship to South at 6 pm took ship to S. W. & W. shored
 sail fine pleasant weather middle strong winds at
 about 10 o'clock steered E. S. E. with short sail West Coast
 to land to lower boats a high sea on Lat 37.02^N Long 36.00^W

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 14th
 Winds from W. steering East with close sail too bad weather
 to lower boats at night shortened sail heavy weather
 middle & latter parts a strong Gale Lat by obs 37.04^N
 Long 33.50^W

Remarks on board Sunday Sept 15th
 a strong Gale from W. S. W. steering to East
 with short sail at night a little more windnet
 but a heavier sea on the vessel. work well
 middle a little more windnet latter part a Gale
 Steered E. S. E. before the wind saw a sail steering
 S. at noon a little more windnet Lat 38-06^N Long 30.60^W

Remarks on board Monday Sept 16th - 65th
 a strong Gale from W. S. W. steering East at
 night reared ship to W. S. W. on a heavier sea
 on from S. W. winds from S. W. winds more windnet
 middle & latter parts strong strong Gale with
 a heavy sea heavier Gale a heavy sea
 at noon a little more windnet Lat 38.44^N Long 29.05^W

Remarks on board Tuesday Sept 17th
 a strong Gale from S. steering heading to S. W.
 with close reefed foresail at 5 o'clock more
 windnet reared ship to E. S. E. set reefed Gale &
 close reefed mainsail at night thick & heavy
 weather the sea more windnet latter part fine
 pleasant weather Steered South at noon Lat 37.46^N Long 29.05^W

Remarks on board Wednesday Sept 18th
 fine pleasant weather Steered East at night shored
 sail Fuzer inside having a S. E. Dist. 35 miles Steering
 on a wind to S. E. with short sail fine pleasant weather
 latter part steering East in for the land at noon
 the Island bore E. S. E. Dist 35 miles



Remarks on board Thursday Sept 19th
 fine pleasant weather steering E. S. E. saw the point
 of Fuzer at 8 pm anchored in a pretty bay water
 several vessels at anchor we anchored & gave 60 shots
 three fine muzzles flared but no fire present
 weather employed in getting our cables from water

Remarks on board Friday Sept 20th
 fine pleasant weather got one raft of water on board
 & shored down at night at 9 o'clock took a raft of cork
 on shore & water employed in new cables to sail
 out to anchor
